Pray, too, for staff and other students at the Rocklands Primary School and for Pastor Tshabalala. This Bible League-trained leader uses our Bible studies to share God’s Word with students there.

they teach English and share Bible stories. Pray that these children—and their parents—will put their faith in Jesus.

Praise God! Children in two places in **Madagascar**'s central highlands recently completed the *Discovery Basic 1* book in Bible League's new *Discovery Series*. Now they're excited to start the second book. Pray that these children will grow in and put their faith in God and follow Him throughout their lives.

Week 2

Praise the Lord for Pastor James' two ministry outreaches in the **Philippines**. He has used Bible League's Bible studies with 56 adults and 30 children. Pray that those who have studied and come to understand God's Word will come together to form a church, where their faith will grow. Pray, too, that Pastor James will raise up more leaders to work alongside him.

Bible League's team in **Mozambique** recently reintroduced our Bible studies in the prison facility in Boane. Give thanks that inmates as well as guards are taking part in the studies. This is the first time the Bible studies have been held in the prison since the COVID-19 pandemic.

Join Bible League's team in **Malawi** in thanking God for opening doors to bring the Good News of Jesus Christ to people in the country's Mangochi District. Pray that God's Word will take hold of hearts in this area that is a Muslim stronghold.

Week 3

"Pray for the peace and grace of Christ to conquer people's hearts and minds." This request comes from our team in **Armenia**, where more than 100,000 ethnic Armenians who fled Nagorno-Karabakh [Artsakh]

are now refugees. Bible League-trained Christians in Armenia are using our Bible studies to reach them with the Good News of Jesus Christ.

Rejoice and give thanks to God. Bible League's director in **Pakistan** reports that three brothers from Muslim communities have made a serious commitment to Jesus and were baptized. Pray that their faith will grow and that they will be a light to others.

Extreme violence in **Haiti** continues. Bible League-trained church planter Melissa serves the Lord near Port-au-Prince, the capital, but often must flee the area. Recently, one of her brothers was hospitalized after being shot 11 times. She asks you to pray for the situation in her country.

Week 4

Bible League's team in **Madagascar** is expanding its work into the northern and western regions of that country. Pray that God will advance His mission in these areas.

Nikodemus, a Bible League-trained leader in **Indonesia**, is now teaching Bible-based Literacy in his village. Our team there reports that he is also a trained Bible study leader and part of the Arfak tribe. While many in that people group say they are Christians, few have a personal relationship with Jesus. He is the first man from the Arfak tribe to learn and teach English. Pray for many there to find new life in Jesus Christ.

God continues to build his Church in **Bangladesh**. Seventeen Chakma people from a Buddhist background were baptized near the end of June. Praise God! Pray that these new believers will grow in their faith and relationship with Christ.
