- Typhoon Yagi, Asia's most powerful storm this year, affected northern Thailand and parts of Vietnam, Myanmar, and Laos. After hovering over the region for almost two weeks, it finally caused a three-day deluge of rain in the northern district of Chiang Mai, Thailand. A flash flood rushed down from the mountains, flooding Chiang Mai City, where Bible League's office is located.

# PRAY FOR Worldwide Ministry

### Week 1

Pray for people **worldwide**—including those in the southeastern U.S.—whose lives have been turned upside down by recent hurricanes and typhoons. Pray that people will look to the Lord to find strength and comfort.

Pray especially for ministry in **Thailand**, where Bible League's office and warehouse were flooded. Water levels reached almost three feet and destroyed computers, desks, bookshelves, tables, and chairs in the office. Prior to being able to clean the warehouse,

our director an estimated 30-40% of the Bibles and materials may have been damaged or destroyed. Believers from local churches and Christian organizations are helping our team clean up. Pray that the ministry will continue without delay, and that Scriptures will be able to be replaced quickly.

### Week 2

Join in thanking God for the many opportunities He is putting before Bible League to share God's Word in the **U.S.** Pray that God will give leaders wisdom as they decide which churches they should work with in the coming year. Right now, they have more requests for training than they can currently handle.

Thank God for a group of visually impaired people in **Zambia** who recently received Audio Bibles for the first time. All they had known previously were Braille Bibles. One of Bible League Zambia's co-directors shares, "Let God be praised for creating this opportunity to have special people receive this gift with humility and appreciation."

Bible League's team in **Argentina** asks for prayers as they plan to provide more than 10,000 Bibles to different prisons in their country.

#### Week 3

Bible League's team in the **Dominican Republic** is working to develop Bible League's Bible studies in the country's interior provinces of Monte Plata, Sabana Grande de Boya, and Nagua. So far, more than 300 trained Bible study leaders have reached more than 3,000 people with God's Word. Give God the praise and glory.

Pray for Bible League's Bible-based Literacy classes taking place in prisons in **Nepal**, including those in Hetauda, Bhimfedi, Dhankuta, and Damauli. Pray that many may come to know the Lord. Praise God for the seven people who were recently baptized. Pray for their spiritual growth so that their lives may glorify the Lord.

Pray for Juan 3:18 Church in Mérida, **Venezuela**. Church members plan to use Bible study materials you help provide to serve 500 children in their community.

#### Week 4

Pray for a positive outcome of a meeting between Bible League's team in **Indonesia** and the leadership of the Indonesian Defense University. If our request is approved, we will use Bible League's Bible study materials with their Christian cadets during each academic year.

Please continue to pray for peace for **Armenia** and this area of the world. Bible League's ministry director in that country says, "We sincerely thank and appreciate all our Christian brothers and sisters who faithfully and regularly pray for our requests. God's blessings to all of you!"
