Week 1

In **Burundi**'s provinces of Gitega, Muramvya, Mwaro, and Bujumbura Mairie, more than 3,000 students have graduated from Bible League's Bible study program. They are from 30 different schools and universities. Pray for God's Word to take root in these young hearts.

Please pray for the more than 600 people across **Rwanda** in Ngarama, Rutoma, and Mimuli as they graduate

from their Bible League Bible studies. May they grow in faith and share it with others in their communities.

Praise God for the 40 churches in **Malawi**'s Dzaleka refugee camp that are using Bible League's Bible studies. Ask the Lord to ready the hearts of those who will hear the Good News for the first time.

Pray for the 50 Tapa Abotoase, **Ghana**, school teachers who received training to lead Bible League Bible studies. May God open doors for them to share the Gospel with their students.

Week 2

Thank God for the Bible League Bible study leader training for 30 Hmong Christians in northern **Vietnam**. Pray for these new leaders as they use Bible League's materials to begin small group Bible studies in their own churches in the coming months. May the material and training grow Hmong churches.

Ask the Lord to bring peace to people in **Indonesia**'s Highland Papua Province. Bible study groups there are facing challenges due to heightened political tensions there. Pray for the leaders remain steadfast and faithful during this situation.

Recently, the Gospel was shared with people in a village in northern **Bangladesh** bordering India. The Word of God touched people's hearts. Praise the Lord for how He is drawing hearts to Him. Ask God to deepen their faith as they study His Word.

Thank God for the 12 believers in central **Nepal** who are sharing the Gospel through Bible League's Bible studies. Through them, 18 people have already come to faith in Christ. Pray for them to grow in the strength and knowledge of Christ as they study the Bible.

Week 3

Please pray for those who will flee from Syria to **Armenia**. May God surround them with His loving arms. Ask the Lord to give wisdom to believers in Armenia as they try to embrace this opportunity to spread the hope of Jesus to the refugees in their country.

Pray for Hovhannes as he begins Bible League children's Bible studies throughout several villages in **Armenia**'s Armavir Province. Pray for these young ones to know how much their heavenly Father loves them.

In the wake of the revolt in **Syria**, concerns are rising high. Yazan, our ministry leader in the area, asks, "Please pray for the dozens of churches in Syria that have adopted Bible League Bible studies and the Bible-based Literacy program. From our partners there, we heard that all the churches have closed their doors, especially in northern Syria, after the armed opposition took control. One of the pastors asked me to continue praying so that the church can fulfill its mission in such circumstances. Pray for us as we serve them."

Week 4

Pray for Pastor Aleida as she shares the Gospel in **Cuba**. Access to fuel outside the capital is still very limited. May the Lord provide all that Pastor Aleida and others need so the hope of the Good News can continue to spread.

Ask the Lord to bring hope and healing to the people of **Haiti**. Melissa and Doceline, two Bible Leaguetrained church planters, had their houses burnt down by armed gangs. Another pastor, Jean Paul, planned to hold a Bible study leader training but the homes of 10 of his church members were burned down. Jean Paul also fled his home.

In **Texas**, a ministry received Bibles which they plan to use for children in their city as well as prisoners and the homeless. Pray for the Lord to soften the hearts of those attending after-school programs and Bible studies.
